Zayna Rizvi and Excellent Win Speed Leg of Junior Jumper Championship



The final class of the opening day of the 2022 Devon Horse set in the iconic Dixon Oval, the \$3,750 Junior Jumper, sponsored by Land Services USA, Inc., saw a field of 23 talented young competitors take to the ring to vie for the top honors. As the first leg of the Junior Jumper Championship, the speed class asked riders to navigate the obstacles efficiently and fault-free if they were to be in contention for the ribbons. At the conclusion of the rounds, it was Zayna Rizvi and Excellent who emerged victorious on top of the leaderboard.

Course designer Olaf Petersen, Jr. (GER) set a challenging 13-jump track for exhibitors, asking them to make their way through multiple difficult turns and a combination line within a time-allowed of 89 seconds. In a race against the clock, the win was anyone's for the taking. Setting the pace as the first to contest the course, Baylee McKeever and Formidable, owned by McLain Ward, took an early lead with a fault-free round and a time of 71.059 seconds. Just three rounds later, McKeever was unseated by Carlee McCutcheon aboard her own MTM Unexpected. The duo left all of the rails intact, finishing in a swift 69.659 seconds to move into the leading position.

Having already dominated in the equitation divisions Thursday, topping a section of both the Washington Equitation Classic Jumper Phase and the Platinum Performance / USEF Show Jumping Talent Search, Rizvi returned to the Dixon Oval determined to nab another Devon blue. Just two rounds following McCutcheon, Rizvi navigated Chaplin W, owned by Peacock Ridge LLC, through the track with ease, shaving nearly two seconds off of McCutcheon's leading time to cross the timers in 67.935 seconds. It seemed victory would be hers for the taking as she managed to hold the lead for 10 rounds until Sofia Cady entered riding her own Deleyn.

With one more shot at the win, Rizvi re-entered the arena aboard her second mount Excellent, owned by Peacock Ridge LLC. Having already contested the course riding Chaplin W, Rizvi knew where she needed to make up valuable time in order to claim back her spot at the top. She turned and burned her way through the track with finesse, crossing the beams in an impressive 65.057 seconds to move back into the first place position. In the end, the remaining two pairs could not catch her time, ultimately lending her the first place finish. Cady claimed second place with Deleyn, while Rizvi rounded out the top three with Chaplin W. Rizvi was also awarded the Flight Cup Perpetual Trophy, presented in memory of Fran and Lou Jaffe and donated by Reed Kessler in 2011.

Zayna Rizvi and Avery Glynn Open 2022 Devon Horse Show with Top Equitation Results





Top equitation riders from around the country convened at the Devon Horse Show's Dixon Oval Thursday, eager to kick off the week dedicated to junior competition. The Platinum Performance / USEF Show Jumping Talent Search 3*, sponsored by Courtyard Marriott, was highlighted in the afternoon packed with a talented field of exhibitors. In Section A of the class, Zayna Rizvi emerged victorious aboard Acer K. Section B saw Avery Glynn earn the top prize with Gerardus.

Paul Jewell (USA) fashioned a 14-obstacle track for the class that challenged riders to prove their confidence, style, and accuracy in the irons around a technical show jumping course under the pressure of a time-allowed. Several double combinations, a vertical-oxer-vertical triple combination, a triple bar, and some long bending lines added to the difficulty of the task at hand. With any jumping faults accumulated being factored into the riders' scores, they were especially incentivized to ride clean around the course.

At the conclusion of Section A, Rizvi was awarded the top placing by the judges on Acer K. Rizvi is no stranger to the winner's circle in the equitation ring, having topped the 2021 ASPCA Maclay National Championship at the National Horse Show riding Finnick. Earlier in the day Thursday, she also took the win in the California Split Section A of the Washington Equitation Classic - Jumper Phase, also riding North Run's Acer K, an 11-year-old Warmblood gelding. Rizvi was also awarded the Honey Craven Memorial Perpetual Trophy, donated in 2004 by Jane Macelree, for riding to the highest scoring round of the day.

In Section B, it was Avery Glynn and Gerardus, owned by Georgy Maskrey-Segesman, who topped the leaderboard. Though only Glynn's third time competing with the 11-year-old Dutch Warmblood gelding, the pair expertly tackled the course, which featured an open water obstacle, and continued to consistently perform during the flat phase. The flat test asked the top 12 athletes to demonstrate a number of tasks, including a sitting trot, a counter-cater and extended canter. Marking Glynn's first trip to the Devon Horse Show, it was made even more memorable by securing the iconic Devon blue.

In the Washington International Horse Show (WIHS) Equitation Classic Jumper Phase, sponsored by Courtyard Marriot, earlier in the day, it was Rizvi on Acer K once again who claimed the blue ribbon in the first half of the California Split with a score of 92. Alexa Leong on Donald Stewart's Any Given Sunday took the red ribbon in the first half of the split with a score of 89. In the second half of the California Split, it was Luke Jensen aboard North Run's Jamaica who earned first place with a score of 90. Taylor Cawley on Mamba, owned by Blanca Equine LLC, finished in second place for the day.

Section B of the WIHS Equitation Classic Jumper Phase saw just as much tough competition in the Dixon Oval. When the time had come for the prize giving, it was Kingsley Dey on her own Joker De Fallogne who took first place in the first half of the California Split with a score of 91. Kaitlyn Kiely earned the second place ribbon just behind Dey, riding Kiely Equestrian LLC's The Original to a score of 88. In the second half of the California Split, Ellie Aronson took the blue with a score of 90 aboard Wolfstone Stables & Sales Inc.'s Conthacco. Sofia Cady on Brookside Pine Farms, LLC's Konfessions earned second place with a score of 80 in the split to round out the class on Thursday.



USPC Mounted Games

Mounted Games are an exciting, face-paced event originally the idea of His Royal Highness, Prince Philip, as a way to encourage enthusiasm, participation, and training in younger riders without the need of expensive ponies. A natural draw to all levels of riding abilities, Games provide a fun sport that teaches the basic natural aids, physical coordination, self-confidence, and teamwork skills. It also fosters sportsmanship and the proper care of mounts in new and younger members. Mounted Games competitions are comprised of several relay-style races requiring riders to pick up objects from the ground while remaining in the saddle, weave through a series of poles at high speeds, hand items off to teammates without slowing their ponies, and dunking objects into buckets (sometimes at a gallop!).

WIHS Shetland Pony Steeplechase

And they're off! Pint-sized jockeys and Shetland Ponies will be lining up in the Dixon Oval on Sunday, May 29, and Monday, May 30, for the start of the 2022 WIHS Shetland Pony Steeplechase Championship Series, presented by Charles Owen. The Devon Horse Show will once again host the first leg of this special "mini-series," which will culminate at the Washington International Horse Show at Show Place Arena in Washington, D.C., October 24-30, 2022. The riders and their mounts are schooled and well prepared by U.S. Pony Racing, the exhibition organizer. Come out this Memorial Day weekend and cheer on the junior jockeys and speedy ponies as they take over the Dixon Oval!
